BILL 65 (2023), AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CODE BY EXPANDING THE VOLUNTEER PARKING ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM (WASSP-6)

Dear Chair Sinenci and Committee Members:

The Maui Police Department currently has no comments or suggested revisions for Bill 65, CD1.

Please find the requested responses below:

- 1. Yes, if we create a new policy, it will need to be reviewed by State of Hawai'i Organization of Police Officers (SHOPO). The main concern is how we will manage civilians issuing citations.
- 2. Yes. In summary, Honolulu Police Department's program enlists volunteers who must meet the following criteria: possess a valid Hawaii driver's license, be a U.S. citizen and local resident, be at least 21 years old, and hold a high school diploma or equivalent. They are also required to pass a background check and adhere to all department standards. Volunteers must complete training and work a minimum of 20 hours per month. Their responsibilities are limited to enforcing parking laws and ordinances, and the program is managed by the Traffic Division."
- 3. We currently plan to implement a pilot program in the Hana District. Based on the results of this pilot, we will assess the program and develop a budget and parameters moving forward.
- 4. We will likely adopt the same requirements for volunteers as those established by Honolulu Police Department.
