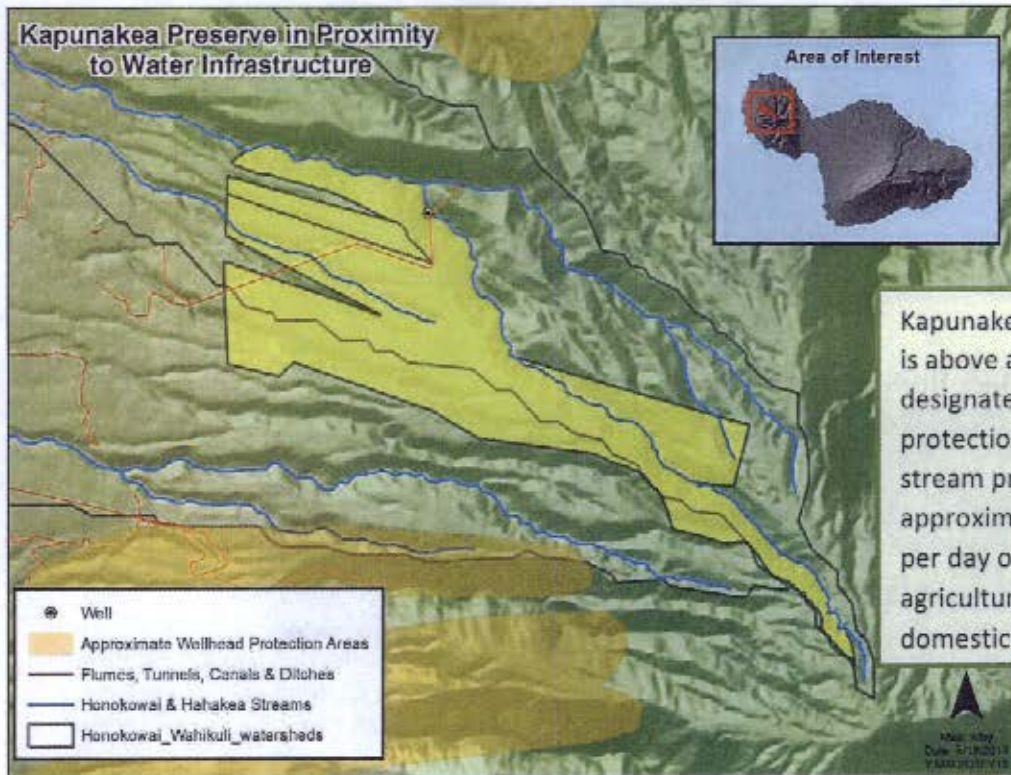


# The Nature Conservancy's Maui Program DWS Watershed Grants Program



## Kapunakea Preserve, West Maui



Kapunakea's forested watershed is above and adjacent to county designated source water protection areas. Honokowai stream produces on average approximately 3.5 million gallons per day of fresh water a day for agricultural and potentially domestic use.

*We use the DWS funding as match for the State Natural Area Preserve program which provides \$2 of state funding for every \$1 of non-state match. We significantly leverage both County and State funds for private and federal funding. Much of this funding is variable and we have to fight hard for it year to year, and the State NAPP program has recently been cut 10%.*
