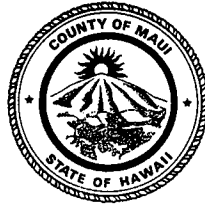

## RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF ALALANI HILL AS THE NATIVE HAWAIIAN TRADITIONAL AND CUSTOMARY PRACTICES EXPERT TO THE MAUI PLANNING COMMISSION

WHEREAS, by correspondence dated September 7, 2017, Mayor Alan M. Arakawa notified the Council he nominated Alalani Hill to the Maui Planning Commission for a term expiring on March 31, 2018, to fill a vacancy replacing Doreen Canto, pursuant to Sections 2.28.010 and 2.28.070, Maui County Code, and Sections 8-8.4 and 13-2, Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended, (“Charter”); and

WHEREAS, Charter Section 13-2, requires the Mayor’s nominee to be approved by the Council; and

WHEREAS, Charter Section 13-2(17), requires the Council to approve or disapprove the nomination within sixty days after the Mayor submits the name of the nominee to the Council because of the death, resignation, or removal of a member; and

WHEREAS, Charter Section 8-8.4 contains specific provisions relating to the Maui Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.28.070, Maui County Code, requires each planning commission and the Hana advisory committee to have at least one member to have demonstrated expertise in native Hawaiian traditional and customary practices, as evidenced by one or more of the following credentials:

1. A college degree in a relevant field, such as Hawaiian studies, native Hawaiian law, native Hawaiian traditional and customary practices, including traditional environmental practices, or related subject area.
2. Work history that demonstrates an appropriate level of knowledge in native Hawaiian traditional and customary practices, including traditional environmental practices.
3. Substantial experience as a native Hawaiian traditional and customary practitioner; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

1. That it approves the appointment of Alalani Hill to serve on the Maui Planning Commission for a term expiring March 31, 2018;
2. That it approves and designates the said Alalani Hill as the Maui planning commission member that possesses the required expertise in native Hawaiian traditional and customary practices;
3. That the Council expresses its gratitude and appreciation to Alalani Hill for her willingness to be considered for public service and actively participate in County government; and
4. That certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor, the Managing Director, and the Corporation Counsel.
