Subject: Hana Visitorship

To the EACP Committee Members:

We are being over-run with tourists.
Our infrastructures are inadequate.
Something has to be done to reduce the number of tourists who drive out to Hana each day.

It is my recommendation that we institute a toll and create a system via license plates to allow either odd or even numbered vehicles to come to Hana on specific days. If the license plate of a tourist's car ends in an even number, they can drive out to Hana on M-W-or F. If they have an odd numbered plate they can come out to Hana on T-TH-& Sat.

This is the system that the State of California used in the early 80's when there was gas rationing. IT WORKED!

If a visitor has a hotel or legal B & B or vacation rental confirmed reservation, they are given, by the legal entity, a pass that they have to show at the toll booth. This would allow them access to travel any day of the week, no matter what their license plate reads. This will also help to curtail the use of illegal STR's in the Hana area since only permitted accommodations would be issued the pass.

The toll would pay for the staff required at both ends of the highway leading to Hana from the north and from the south.

Residents would have a special sticker that would allow them to travel any day of the week.
