SUBJECT: RESOLUTION 24-155, AUTHORIZING THE COUNCIL CHAIR TO ISSUE A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR A FEASIBILITY STUDY OF A COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF GRANTS MANAGEMENT (ESCS-6)

The Department of Fire & Public Safety is in receipt of your letter dated September 27, 2024. Please see our responses below.

1. In the Fiscal Year ("FY") 2025 Council Adopted Budget, Appendix A, Part I, attached, you project your Department will receive 12 grants. Do you anticipate applying for more grants in FY 2025 than you are projected to receive? Please explain.

Yes, we anticipate applying for more grants than we receive. Please note that the grants included in our budget do not represent what we expect to receive, but rather what we anticipate we may apply for. While we have a pretty good track record, we never expect to receive every grant we apply for.

2. It does not appear your Department employs Grants Specialist. Please explain which department personnel handles grants in lieu of a Grants Specialist.

We have several personnel involved with our grant program. The Assistant Chief of Support Services oversees most of our grants, although the Fire Chief and other

designated personnel will oversee certain grant programs as well. Most of our grant applications are completed and submitted by a uniformed firefighter (currently ranked Fire Fighter III) who has agreed to take on this responsibility in addition to his actual emergency response duties. Another firefighter (currently ranked Fire Fighter III) has recently undergone some training and will be assisting moving forward. These personnel are paid overtime for whatever work they perform while not on duty.
