RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF CHRISTOPHER WILLIAMS TO THE POLICE COMMISSION

WHEREAS, by correspondence dated March 7, 2018, Mayor Alan M. Arakawa notified the Council he nominated Christopher Williams to the Police Commission for a term expiring March 31, 2022, to fill a vacancy replacing Maxwell "Max" Tsai, pursuant to Section 2.41.080, Maui County Code ("MCC"), and Sections 8-12.2 and 13-2, Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended ("Charter"); and


WHEREAS, Charter Section 13-2, requires the Mayor's nominee to be approved by the Council; and

WHEREAS, Charter Section 13-2(17), requires the Council to approve or disapprove the nomination within sixty days after the Mayor submits the name of the nominee to the Council because of the death, resignation, or removal of a member; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

1. That it disapproves the appointment of Christopher Williams to serve on the Police Commission for a term expiring March 31, 2022;
2. That the Council, however, expresses its gratitude and appreciation to Christopher Williams for his willingness to be considered for public service and actively participate in County government; and
3. That certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor, the Managing Director, and the Corporation Counsel.
