A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS AND THE DIRECTOR OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish additional qualifications, pursuant to Section 6-4, Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended ("Charter"), for the Director of Public Works and the Director of Environmental Management, both of whom are appointed by the Mayor. More specific qualifications will help identify skilled, experienced individuals to lead the County's departments, strengthen operations, and better serve the public.

SECTION 2. The Maui County Code is amended by adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

"Chapter 2.14

SPECIFIC QUALIFICATIONS OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEADS OF DEPARTMENTS

Sections:

- 2.14.010 Additional qualifications.
- 2.14.020 Director of public works.
- 2.14.030 Director of environmental management.

2.14.010 Additional qualifications. The specific qualifications of administrative heads of departments established in this chapter are in addition to any qualifications set forth in the

revised charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended (the "Charter").

- **2.14.020 Director of public works.** The director of public works shall have the following minimum qualifications:
 - 1. As set forth in the Charter, five years of experience in an administrative capacity, either in public service or private business, or both.
 - 2. As a part of or in addition to the five years of administrative experience, three years of responsible managerial and budgetary experience.
 - 3. A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in engineering, business administration, public administration, or other relevant discipline, or a combination of education and work experience substantially equivalent to such a bachelor's degree.
- **2.14.030 Director of environmental management.** The director of environmental management shall have the following minimum qualifications:
 - 1. As set forth in the Charter, five years of experience in an administrative capacity, either in public service or private business, or both.
 - 2. As a part of or in addition to the five years of administrative experience, three years of responsible managerial and budgetary experience.
 - 3. A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in engineering, environmental science, water resources, business administration, public administration, or other relevant discipline, or a combination of education and work experience substantially equivalent to such a bachelor's degree."

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect on January 2, 2019.
