**SUBJECT: KA HALE A KE OLA WESTSIDE SHELTER (HHT-20)**

Thank you for your correspondence of August 24, 2017 requesting a timeline of ownership related to the buildings situated on the 5-acre County parcel leased to Ka Hale A Ke Ola (KHAKO) for the Westside Shelter.

Maui Economic Concerns of the Community (MECC) was the original borrower and owner and remains so today. MECC's name was legally changed to Ka Hale A Ke Ola on November 17, 2010. Therefore, there has only been one owner since the loan was made in 2003, that being KHAKO (formerly known as MECC).

As noted in Exhibit A of the proposed resolution which was previously transmitted by the department, construction was complete as of December 31, 2003. The closing date of the loan was April 30, 2003.
