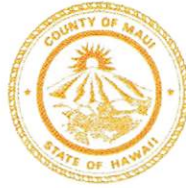

**SUBJECT: AMENDMENTS TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2026 BUDGET
(INCREASING ESTIMATED REVENUES,

On behalf of the Department of Human Concerns, I am transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2026 BUDGET, INCREASING ESTIMATED REVENUES, CARRYOVER/SAVINGS, GENERAL FUND BY, \$162,500, DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN CONCERNS, HUMAN CONCERNS PROGRAM, GRANTS AND DISBURSEMENTS FOR HEALTH, HUMAN SERVICES, AND EDUCATION, INCREASE THE APPROPRIATION FOR HOUSELESS PROGRAMS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$162,500."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2026 Budget, to 1) Increase Estimated Revenues, Carryover/Savings, General Fund by \$162,500, 2) amend Category B – Operations & Equipment for Department of Human Concerns, Human Concerns Program, Grants and disbursements for health, human services, and education, to increase the appropriation for Houseless Programs in the amount of \$162,500; and 3) increase the Total Capital Improvement Project Appropriations and Total Appropriations by \$162,500.

These funds will be used for the Safe Parking Pilot Program. The contracted organization has identified increased site work costs in the amount of \$125,000. This amendment request includes these funds along with a contingency of 15 percent as recommended by the Department of Management CIP Coordinator. The site work includes sewer, electrical, water, and other necessary work to prepare the site to accommodate safe parking.



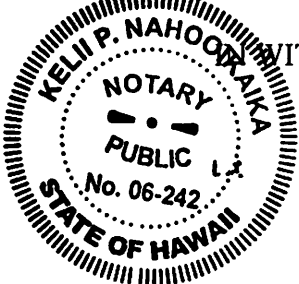

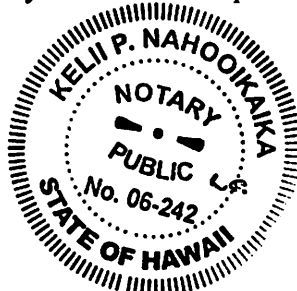
