## APPOINTMENT OF A MEMBER TO THE MAUI COUNTY CULTURAL RESOURCES COMMISSION

WHEREAS, by correspondence dated May 21, 2025, Mayor Richard T. Bissen, Jr. notified the Council he nominated the person listed in Exhibit “A,” as attached, as a member to the Maui County Cultural Resources Commission, in accordance with Sections 2.40.110 and 2.88.030, Maui County Code, and Section 13-2, Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended (“Charter”); and

WHEREAS, Charter Section 13-2 requires the Mayor’s nominee to be approved by the Council; and

WHEREAS, Charter Section 13-2(17) requires the Council to approve or disapprove the Mayor’s nomination within thirty days after the Mayor submits the name of the nominee to the Council and shall immediately so notify the Mayor of its action; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

1. That it approves the appointment of the person listed in Exhibit “B,” as attached, as a member to the Maui County Cultural Resources Commission for the term specified;
2. That it disapproves the appointment of the person listed in Exhibit “C,” as attached, as a member to the Maui County Cultural Resources Commission as nominated by the Mayor;
3. That the Council expresses its gratitude and appreciation to the appointed member for her willingness to be considered for public service and actively participate in County government; and
4. That certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor, the Managing Director, and the Corporation Counsel.
