

**SUBJECT: CORRECTION No. 1: REQUESTS/QUESTIONS FROM THE APRIL 2,
2018 MEETING (FS-2) (BF-1)**

We apologize, but while reviewing our response to your communications dated April 3, 2018 regarding questions posed to our Department at the Budget and Finance Committee meeting of April 2, 2018, our staffers' noticed that Question 4, had incomplete information. The corrections have been made and are indicated in bold.

4. *What is the total cost for phase two relating to the electrical upgrade of the transfer switches for Lanai, Hana, Lahaina, Napili, and Hoolehua Fire Stations?*

The stations mentioned in question #4 above are phase one and also includes installing a transfer switch for the Fire Prevention warehouse. The warehouse would need emergency power since it will be the Department's command post during disasters. The warehouse does not have a generator, but can accept a portable generator if they have a transfer switch installed. The total cost for the electrical upgrade for phase one is \$130,000. Phase two is the upgrading of transfer switches at **the following (5), fire stations which are;** Wailuku, Makawao, Paia, Kihei and Kula fire stations. The total cost

for phase two is estimated to be around \$100,000. We have not yet completed the comprehensive assessments for phase two.
