A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3.48, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO USE OF THE TERM "POLICE"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Section 10.08.010, Maui County Code, is amended by amending Subsection (A) to read as follows:

"A. It [shall be] is the duty of the officers of the police department or such officers as are assigned by the chief of police to enforce the provisions of this title and all of the state vehicle laws applicable to street traffic in the county. Only officers of the police department may use the term "police" on any vehicle, uniform, badge, identification, or emblem."

SECTION 2. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored. In printing this bill, the County Clerk need not include the brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.

SECTION 3. This ordinance takes effect upon its approval.
