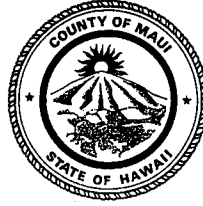

WHEREAS, by correspondence dated May 22, 2017, Acting Mayor Keith A. 
WHEREAS, Charter Section 13-2, requires the Mayor's nominee to be approved by the Council; and
