AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF PRIVATE DONATIONS
TO THE DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT
TO HELP THE COUNTY'S RECOVERY FROM
THE AUGUST 8, 2023 WILDFIRES

WHEREAS, Fukuyama City became a Sister Chamber of the County of Maui on July 18, 1997 with the adoption of Resolution 97-148 and a Sister City on February 11, 2008 with the adoption of Resolution 08-109; and

WHEREAS, Fukuyama City has donated \$47,554 to the County of Maui to help in the County's recovery from the August 8, 2023, wildfires; and

WHEREAS, Kaulana, an organization located in Osaka, Japan, whose Kumu Hula is Kosuke Watanabe, has donated \$199,045 to the County of Maui to help in the County's recovery from the August 8, 2023, wildfires; and

WHEREAS, Miyakojima City has donated \$27,395 to the County of Maui to help in the County's recovery from the August 8, 2023, wildfires; and

WHEREAS, the American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators has donated \$624 to the County of Maui to help in the County's recovery from the August 8, 2023, wildfires; and

WHEREAS, the County has received \$1,479 in donations by check from individuals to the County of Maui to help in the County's recovery from the August 8, 2023, wildfires; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 3.56, Maui County Code, authorizes the Council to accept donations on behalf of the County; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

1. That it accepts the donations of \$47,554 from Fukuyama City, \$199,045 from Kaulana, \$27,395 from Miyakojima City, \$624 from the American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators, and \$1,479 in other various cash donations to help with the recovery from the August 8, 2023, wildfires, under Section 3.56.030, Maui County Code;
2. That it waives any other applicable requirements of Chapter 3.56, Maui County Code;
3. That it expresses its gratitude to Fukuyama City, Kaulana, Miyakojima City, the American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators, the Edward Crapo Trust, and all other donors for their generous donations; and
4. That certified copies of this resolution be transmitted to Naoki Edahiro, Mayor, Fukuyama City; the Council Affairs Office, Fukuyama City; Kosuke Watanabe, Kumu Hula, Kaulana, Osaka, Japan; Roger Grove, President, American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators, Region 4 Board of Directors; Managing Director; and the Mayor of the County of Maui.
