On behalf of the Department of Police, I am transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI, APPENDIX A, PART I, DEPARTMENT OF POLICE, STATE AND FEDERAL ASSETS FORFEITURE PROGRAM."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2025 Budget, Appendix A, Part I, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues – Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2025, to increase the appropriation under the Department of Police, entitled "State and Federal Assets Forfeiture Program" by \$470,000.

The amount included in this amendment reflects funds that accumulated over previous Fiscal Years and were not formally recognized as revenue in prior years. These funds must be used only for law enforcement purposes and not to
