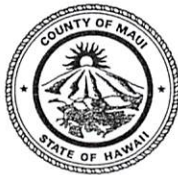

This award is a one year award. The contract period is from July 1, 2018 – June 30, 2019. The continuation of funding beyond the initial 12- month period is contingent on the project's satisfactory performance and the availability of funds. Funds may be withheld if contract requirements are not met or if funds are not available.

The VOCA Program Grant Manual is available to you on the Grants and Planning website (<http://ag.hawaii.gov/cpia/gp/>). The Manual covers the program's fiscal and programmatic requirements. In addition, please familiarize yourself with the requirements in the most recent version of the Department of Justice Grants Financial Guide, which may be accessed at the Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs website (<http://ojp.gov/financialguide/DOJ/index.htm>).

Please be advised that if your organization has expended \$750,000 or more in Federal funds (from all sources including pass-through subawards) in your organization's fiscal year (12-month turnaround reporting period), then you are required to arrange for a single organization-wide audit conducted in accordance with the provisions of Title 2 C.F.R. Subpart F. If your organization has expended less than the applicable audit threshold a year in Federal awards, you are exempt from Federal audit requirements for that year, but you must keep records that are available for review or audit by appropriate officials including the Federal agency, pass-through entity, and U.S. Government Accountability Office (GAO).
