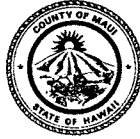

SUBJECT: BIENNIAL REVIEW OF RESIDENTIAL WORKFORCE HOUSING POLICY (CHAPTER 2.96, MAUI COUNTY CODE) (AH-10)
