BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 5816, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2026 Budget," Appendix A, Part I, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues – Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2026, is amended to insert conditional language for 0.9 LTA equivalent personnel for the Department of the Prosecuting Attorney, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program, to read as follows:
