A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A NEW CHAPTER 3.50, MAUI COUNTY CODE, CREATING AN IMMIGRANT SERVICES DIVISION UNITED STATES PASSPORT APPLICATION ACCEPTANCE FACILITY REVOLVING FUND

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Title 3, Maui County Code, is amended by adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

## "Chapter 3.50

# IMMIGRANT SERVICES DIVISION UNITED STATES PASSPORT APPLICATION ACCEPTANCE FACILITY REVOLVING FUND

#### Sections:

3.50.010	Fund establishment.
3.50.020	Purpose.
3.50.030	Deposits to the fund and use.
3 50 040	Administration

- **3.50.010 Fund establishment.** There is established and created a fund to be known as the "Immigrant Services Division United States Passport Application Acceptance Facility Revolving Fund."
- **3.50.020 Purpose.** The fund is established for the purpose of implementation and management relating to immigrant services division's designation as a United States passport application acceptance facility.
- **3.50.030 Deposits to the fund and use**. A. All fees paid to the County of Maui for the immigrant services division's designation

as a United States passport application acceptance facility must be deposited into the fund.

- B. Any balance remaining in this fund at the end of the fiscal year will not lapse, but must remain in the fund accumulating from year to year.
- C. The revenues in this fund may not be used for any purpose except those listed in section 3.50.020.
- D. The director of the department of human concerns must be responsible for the management of the fund.
- **3.50.040 Administration.** A. The director of finance must establish a separate account to record all revenues credited to, and expenditures from, the revolving fund.
- B. Any proposed appropriation will be submitted to the council for approval as a budget appropriation in either the annual budget ordinance or a proposed amendment to the annual budget ordinance."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance takes effect on approval.
