

SUBJECT: RESOLUTION 24-155, AUTHORIZING THE COUNCIL CHAIR TO ISSUE A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR A FEASIBILITY STUDY OF A COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF GRANTS MANAGEMENT (ESCS-6)

We are in receipt of your correspondence dated September 27, 2024 and provide the following responses:

1. In the Fiscal Year ("FY") 2025 Council Adopted Budget, Appendix A, Part I, attached, you project your Department will receive one grant. Do you anticipate applying for more grants in FY 2025 than you are projected to receive? Please explain.

Yes, the Department has applied for and is planning to apply for more grants than the one grant in Appendix A. Appendix A only includes grants that have been awarded, and do not show grants applied for but not yet awarded. The Department of Management applied for nine grants in FY2024 through the Federal Congressionally Directed Spending/Community Project Funding programs that Congress has not yet decided upon. The Office of Recovery (OOR) submitted 58 projects to the state for potential funding through the

Federal Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP). Final applications for the HMGP projects have not yet been submitted, and the Department recognizes it will only be awarded a portion of grants applied for. Finally, OOR is planning to apply for FEMA public assistance grants specifically related to emergency response. These grants may or may not be awarded before the end of FY2025.


