


MEMA STRATEGIES

- **Providing Training Opportunities** Incident Command System courses and certifications to ALL partners (Professional Services)
- Oversee Training and Exercise Program Table-top and full-scale exercises; plans development (Professional Services)
- **Strengthening the EOC** furniture, video wall, computer equipment, technology, IMT capacity (Machinery and Equipment)(Professional Services)
- **Promoting Community Resilience** Hazards Awareness and Resiliency Program, CERT, Community Resiliency Hubs, Public Messaging Campaign



The PLAN is to improve and increase the total activity, effort, progress, and overall PERFORMANCE of the agency.





• 4 Levels of EOC Activation

• Partial – Contact partners based on incident needs.

• Full – Mass notification to response partners.

• Pacific Disaster Center and visitor industry representatives are on the list of partners.



Emergency Operations Center(EOC)

- New EOC at the Telecom Building.
- 2nd floor will be for IT.
- Expected time to complete is dependent upon chiller delivery. Updated timeline is July 2025.
- Looking into temporary cooling solution to expedite opening.

Emergency Operations Center(EOC)

- \$700,000 furniture and video wall
- \$500,000 Computer equipment, and technology



Emergency Operations Center(EOC)

- Situational Awareness (Video wall and technology)
- Interoperability and interconnectivity (Computer equipment)
- Functionality (Furniture)



Staffing

- **Public Affairs Officer** Focuses on <u>overall</u> <u>communication strategy</u>, stakeholder engagement, and management of the agency's reputation.
 - **Training Specialist** Responsible for the <u>overall</u> organization, management, and delivery of training programs that support emergency management objectives. This includes TTX and full-scale exercises with <u>all county partners</u>, incident command systems courses and certifications, CERT training program, and MEMA Staff Competencies.

Staffing

• **CD Staff Specialist III** – Lead, coordinate, and support emergency management efforts of mitigation, preparedness, response, recovery.

Critical response resource for isolated communities.

• Hire from within the community.



CERT Program

- 600 on current roster
- 30-40 active
- Train the trainer July 2025
- Plan to provide more training as we build instructor capacity.
- Offer higher level ICS courses.



Budget Increase

- 96 million estimated FEMA reimbursement; various projects/departments in the County.
- 20 million Security Checkpoint Contract
- \$300,000 Incident Management Team development, ICS Courses, AAR, CEMP.
 - \$8,000 Training Opportunities, Training Fees
