On behalf of the Department of Fire and Public Safety, I am transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI, APPENDIX A, PART I, DEPARTMENT OF FIRE AND PUBLIC SAFETY."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2024 Budget, Appendix A, Part I, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues – Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2024; Department of Fire and Public Safety; State of Hawai'i, Makena Lifeguard Services by increasing the appropriated amount by \$80,001.

The amount for salaries and premium pay will be reduced from \$1,689,573 to \$1,589,574 and \$180,000 will be allocated for equipment. The reduction in salaries and premium pay will not impact the number of Ocean Safety Officers stationed at Makena or the services provided. The equipment funding will be used to purchase new or replacement equipment after the Department reviews and assesses the existing equipment.
