



Fringe Benefits – Terminal Pay/Salary Adjustments




Terminal Pays/Salary Adjustments


 General Fund: Real Property Tax Rates Proposed





Sewer, Cesspool, Septic, & Reclaim Fees





Landfill Tipping and Permit Fees






