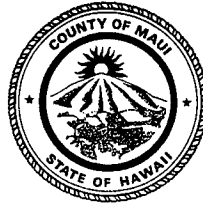

WHEREAS, by correspondence dated March 7, 2018, Mayor Alan M. 
WHEREAS, Charter Section 13-2, requires the Mayor's nominee to be approved by the Council; and
