| 3610 | Fees: Beaches and Parks Parking Passes | <p>The fee for parking passes to park at each designated beach and park location must be as follows:</p> <p>Parking in paid parking zones at beaches and parks must be FREE for residents. To qualify for FREE resident rates, a person must scan a valid driver's license with a State of Hawai'i zip code at parking location.</p> <p>Before 10 am on weekends and County observed holidays, only residents can park in the identified beach and parks parking lots.</p> <p>Resident Parking.....
