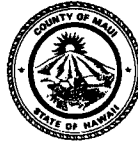

**SUBJECT: FERAL ANIMAL MANAGEMENT ON MAUI** (HFC-24)

At its meeting of January 9, 2020, the Maui County Council's Healthy Families and Communities Committee discussed the topic of feral animal management on Maui.
