## CONGRATULATING THE MAUI GOLD MEDAL WINNERS AT THE 2018 ISLAND MOVERS TRACK AND FIELD STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

WHEREAS, star athletes from four Maui high schools captured a total of 12 gold medals in track titles at the Island Movers Track and Field State Championships on May 11-12, 2018, at Kamehameha Schools Kapālama, O`ahu; and

WHEREAS, Seabury Hall's Veronica Winham claimed three titles in the 800-, 1,500-, and 3,000-meter races, defeating her opponents in photo finishes in the 800- and 1,500-meter races; and

WHEREAS, Baldwin High School's Rey Cadiz captured the gold in the boys 110-meter hurdles, defending his state title, and also won the gold in the boys 300-meter hurdles; and

WHEREAS, Shawn Silva, also from Baldwin High School, secured the gold in the boys high jump after competing in a tiebreaker; and

WHEREAS, Baldwin's Tianna Powell claimed the gold medal in the girls pole vault by clearing 12 feet, beating her personal best by a foot; and

WHEREAS, Micah Au-Hauptu and Keely Logan from Kamehameha Schools Maui clinched titles in the boys shot put and the girls high jump, respectively, becoming the first-ever gold medalists in track and field for their school; and

WHEREAS, Maui High School's Alyssa Mae Antolin recovered from a tough second-place finish in the 100-meter race to claim the title for the 200-meter event; and

WHEREAS, Maui High School's unified relay team, consisting of Jerimiah Abut, Waiohinu Cuello, Gavin Gilo, and Edwin Hayman Jr., won gold in both the unified 4x100-meter relay and the unified 4x400-meter relay; and
