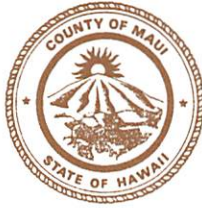

SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET

On behalf of the Department of Management, I am transmitting the attached proposed bill for the purpose of amending the Fiscal Year 2019 Budget by adding an appropriation entitled, "Grant to Lokahi Pacific, Inc.", in the amount of \$250,000 to renovate the Harry and Jeanette Weinberg Pono Center.

Lokahi Pacific is requesting funding to renovate the county-owned Pono Center located at 62 N. Market Street, Wailuku. Maintenance and repair of the 12 year old building is estimated to cost \$130,000, which includes replacement of the roof at \$35,000. In addition, Lokahi Pacific is requesting \$120,000 for construction/renovation plans to convert the ground floor into a single restaurant space as well as a feasibility study to convert the third floor to additional affordable apartment rentals.

For your information, attached is a Certification of Additional Revenues for Fiscal Year 2019 certifying the availability of General Fund Carryover/Savings in the amount of \$250,000 to fund this request.

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI
AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES;
DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT,
MAUI REDEVELOPMENT PROGRAM;
TOTAL OPERATING APPROPRIATIONS; AND
TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4861, Bill No. 57 (2018), as amended, "Fiscal Year 2019 Budget", is hereby amended as it pertains to Section 2, Estimated Revenues, by increasing Carryover/Savings from the General Fund in the amount of \$250,000; and by increasing Total Estimated Revenues in the amount of \$250,000, to read as follows:
