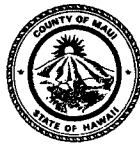

The Committee requested your responses to the following:



3. Please provide the County-employee parking stall wait list, the total number of County parking spaces available, and a copy of the County parking policy.
4. Please provide the details of the cost of a parking meter and approximately how long it takes to pay for itself.
