The Department is in receipt of your correspondence dated March 31, 2024 requesting updates to the authority for several fees under the Department of Public Works in Appendix B to Bill 60 (2024), the Schedule of Fees, Rates, Assessments and Taxes for FY 2025. The Department provides the following responses.

- 1. May I please request you provide a mark-up of those pages containing the updated citations for all fees currently referencing Maui County Code provisions found in:
 - a. Chapter 16.26B, which was repealed and replaced by Chapters 16.26C and 16.25 by Ordinances 5508 and 5507, effective May 1, 2023; and
 - b. Chapter 16.20B, which was repealed and replaced by Chapter 16.20C by Ordinance 5383, effective May 13, 2022.

See attached markup of Appendix B which includes the necessary revisions.

2. By Ordinance 5603 (effective September 1, 2024), Chapter 19.62, Maui County Code, will be repealed, and the responsibility for administering flood hazard areas will be transferred from the Planning Director to the Director of Public Works under a new Chapter 16.29.

Chapter 16.29, Maui County Code. Does any fee apply for the special flood hazard area development permit application and review or any other work performed under the new chapter? Please advise.

There is currently an application fee for flood development permits under the Department of Planning shown on page 31 of Appendix B. It is appropriate to retain the fees under the Department of Planning since the effective date of Ordinance 5603 is not until September 1, 2024, which is after the FY2025 Budget takes effect.

An amendment to Ordinance 5603 is needed to clarify the fee requirement since the current fee established by Chapter 19.510, Maui County Code, will no longer be applicable to flood development permits processed under Chapter 16.29, Maui County Code. The Department intends to pursue needed amendments related to application fees.

3. It appears appropriate to add into the Department's fees language to cover permits for emergency alternations and new construction of structures in disaster-affected areas, under Ordinance 5629, citing Section 16.25.105, Maui County Code. Suggested language follows:

"Building official may defer all plan review and permit fees on written request by applicant. Permit fee for reconstruction of recently built residential structures or commercial structures using previously approved construction plans may be assessed at 50% of permit fee. Deferred fees must be paid before final inspection of structure."

- a. Will this language adequately address the new provisions for emergency permits?
- b. Based on the above, should the language on page 42 relating to emergency reconstruction of single family dwellings and accessory structures, citing Section 16.26B.105.2.1; and the language found on page 44 for a similar circumstance be removed?
