OFFICIAL TESTIMONY LOCATION

Members of the public may view the meeting and provide testimony in person at the Council Chamber, Kalana O Maui Building, 8th Floor, 200 South High Street, Wailuku, Hawai'i.

If audiovisual connection with the Council Chamber is lost, the Council will be in recess for up to 30 minutes to restore connectivity. If connectivity cannot be restored within 30 minutes, the meeting will automatically reconvene the following Wednesday at 9:00 a.m., using the same official location for in-person testimony and viewing, unless the Council announces a different date, time, and location.

TESTIMONY PROCEDURES

Individuals may provide oral testimony by phone or video conference. To join the meeting by phone, call 1-408-317-9253 and input meeting code 295235670. To join by video conference, use the following link: https://maui.bluejeans.com/295235670.

Oral testimony on any agenda item will be accepted at the beginning of the meeting and prior to Council's deliberation on each section of the agenda. Testimony must pertain to items on the agenda. Each testifier shall be allowed to speak for up to three minutes on each item. The time limits for testimony may be modified, if the modification is initiated by the presiding officer and approved by a majority of the Council; provided that a modification would apply equally to all testifiers and all items. No further oral testimony by the testifier on the item shall be permitted. An individual's request to testify may be deemed withdrawn if the individual does not answer when called to testify. If the connection between any testifier and the video conference is lost, the meeting will still continue.

If a testifier wishes to testify anonymously, please indicate that request in the Bluejeans chat or with staff at the sign-up desk outside the Council Chamber. Anonymous testifiers will be assigned a number.

DECORUM

Any person who behaves in a manner that disrupts, disturbs, or impedes the orderly conduct of the Council meeting may, at the discretion of the presiding officer or a majority of present Councilmembers, be removed from the Council Chamber or, if participating remotely, muted or dropped from the meeting. Disruptive behavior includes, but is not limited to: heckling, shouting, use of profanity, and threatening remarks made to any member of the Council, staff, or general public.

WRITTEN TESTIMONY

Written testimony should be received at least 24 hours prior to the meeting; except if a meeting will be held on a Monday, written testimony should be received by noon on the business day preceding the meeting. While the Council requests that written testimony be submitted as noted, testimony submitted after that date and time will still be accepted.
