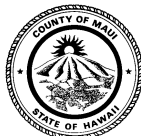

SUBJECT: **FEDERAL DISASTER GRANT REIMBURSEMENTS**
(BFED-20(17))

The Council's Budget, Finance, and Economic Development Committee discussed Federal Disaster Grant Reimbursements at its meeting of December 2, 2025.

May I please request the following for each disaster-related project the Agency manages:

1. A table for each project that includes:
 - a. Federal disaster number.
 - b. County department managing the project, if other than MEMA.
 - c. Project title and brief description.
 - d. Total project costs submitted by the County.
 - e. Dollar amount obligated by the Federal agency.
 - f. Dollar amount encumbered and expended.
 - g. Dollar amount reimbursed to date.

- h. Remaining receivable and the “as of” date for each dollar amount.
 - i. Dates of the County’s key submissions, approvals, and follow-up communications with State and Federal agencies.
 - j. The current stage in the reimbursement process (for example, County review, State review, Federal obligation, State payment).
 - k. Any known issues or risks that could delay reimbursement.
- 2. A table listing receivables that are outstanding for more than 180 days, including for each item:
 - a. Federal disaster number.
 - b. Managing County department.
 - c. Project title.
 - d. Outstanding dollar amount.
 - e. Actions County staff have taken to secure payment.
 - f. Date the State or Federal agency was last contacted.
 - g. Any specific assistance the Committee can provide to resolve the outstanding amounts.
- 3. A list of consultant contracts the County has used to support reimbursement work, including for each contract:
 - a. Consultant name.
 - b. Contract term.
 - c. Total contract amount.
 - d. Funding source.

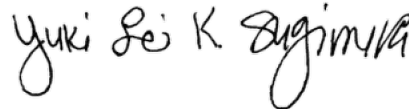

- e. Scope of work.
 - f. Disasters or project covered.
4. A list of projects or cost categories where the Agency believes Federal reimbursement may be denied in whole or in part, if any. For each item, please provide the estimated dollar amount at risk and describe the main reason for concern.
