2. Are Lahaina residents impacted by the August 2023 wildfires subject to the water meter reservation system? If so, are they exempt from the time constraints under Bill 130?

#### Response:

Lahaina residents impacted by the August 2023 wildfires are subject to the water meter reservation system; however, Title 14 has been suspended under the Emergency Proclamation declared by Mayor Richard T. Bissen, Jr., on August 8, 2023, Item 5, Title 14, thereby pausing the term of reservations.

3. How much additional water source is needed to satisfy the number of individuals on the "Upcountry Water Meter List"?

#### Response:

The remaining waitlist comprises a maximum of 3,612 meters. Applying a daily usage assumption of 1,200 gallons per meter per day, approximately 4.3 million gallons per day of additional source is required to satisfy the remainder of the waitlist.
