

BILL 68: TITLE 10 AMENDMENTS

Overview of Changes

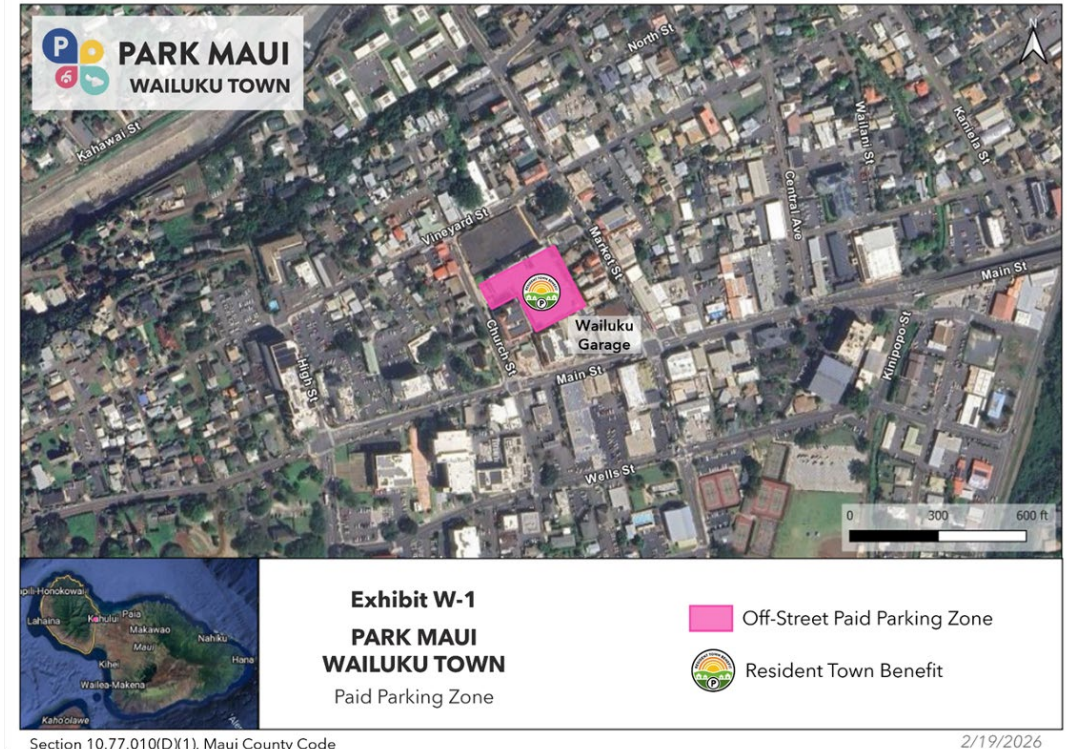
- **Paid Parking Zone**
 - Establish Wailuku Garage as a Resident Town Benefit location
 - Remove Resident Recreation Hour from Kama'ole III Parking Lot 2
 - Maintain Kama'ole I Makai Lot (Paved Lot) and Kama'ole III Parking Lot 1 (Paved Lot) as Resident Recreation Hour locations
 - Establish 750 Luakini Lot, 116 Prison St. Lot, and 500 Front St. Lot as Paid Parking Zones
- **Permit Parking Zone**
 - Establish 750 Luakini Lot in Lahaina as a Permit Parking Zone
- **All PARK MAUI resident benefits** based on scanning of valid Hawai'i driver's license at a pay station on site or on mobile application





Exhibit W-1: Wailuku Town Paid Parking Zone Map

- Amended to include a Resident Town Benefit location
- Resident Town Benefit at Wailuku Garage: First two hours FREE with scanned valid Hawai'i driver's license. \$1/hour after first two hours.

- Amended to remove the Kamaole Beach III Parking Lot 2 as a Resident Recreation Hour location.
- Beach parking is FREE for all Hawaii residents with valid Hawaii driver's license.
- Resident Recreation Hour: At designated beaches, resident-only parking before 10 a.m. on weekends and County- observed holidays.

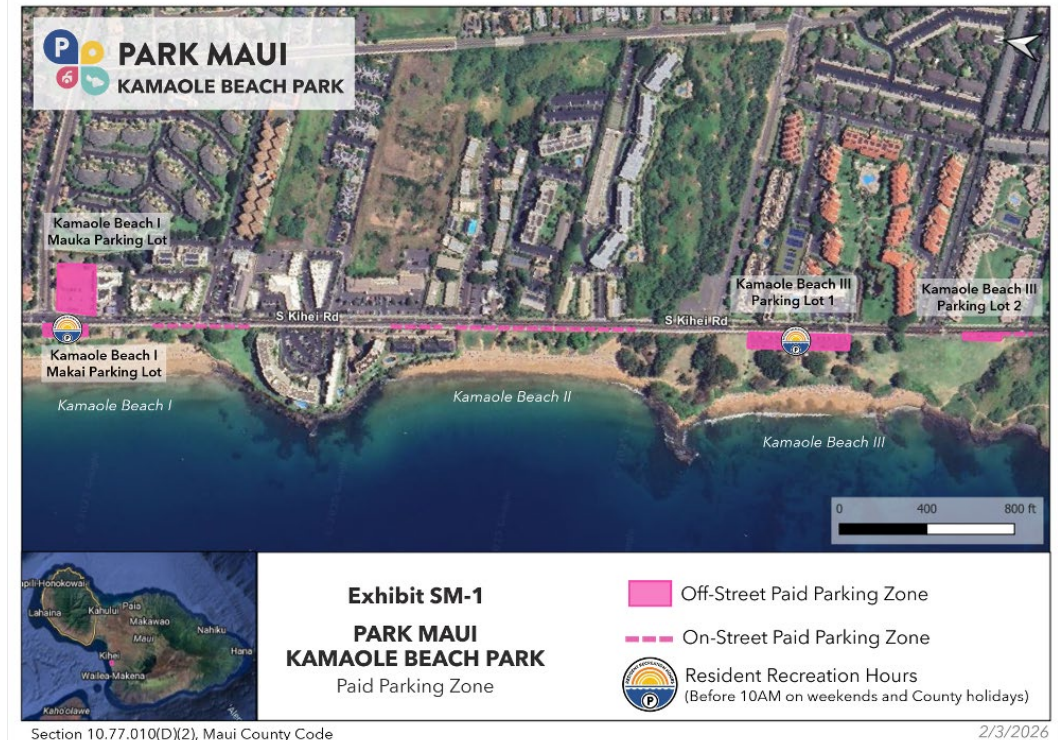
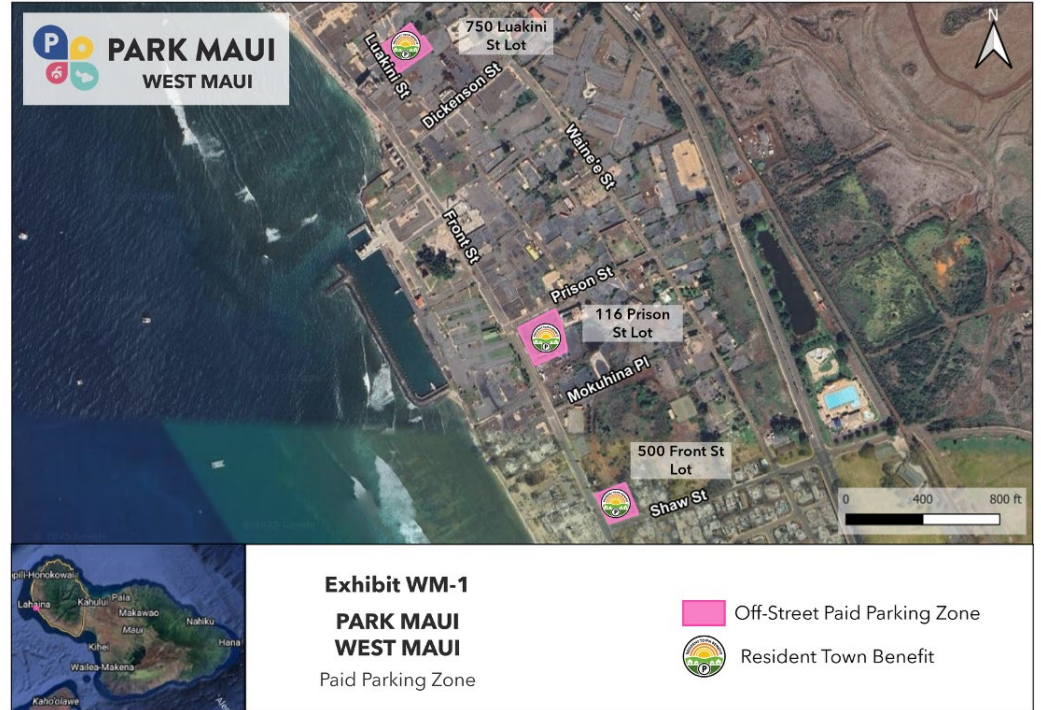




Exhibit WM-1: West Maui Paid Parking Zone Map

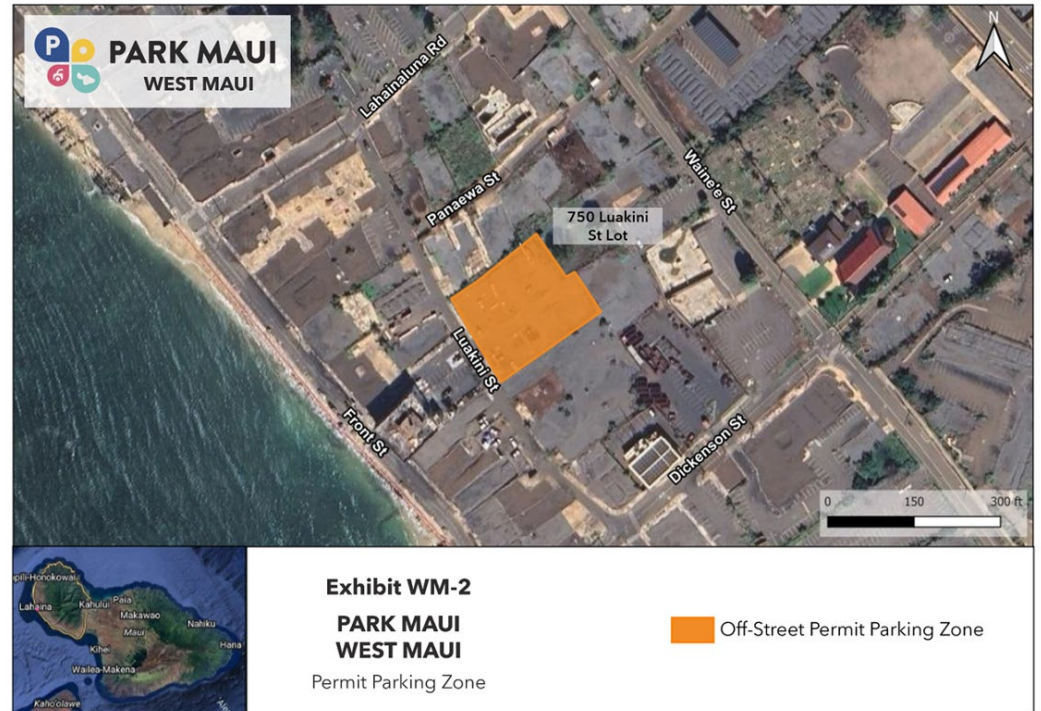

Exhibit WM-2: West Maui Permit Parking Zone Map

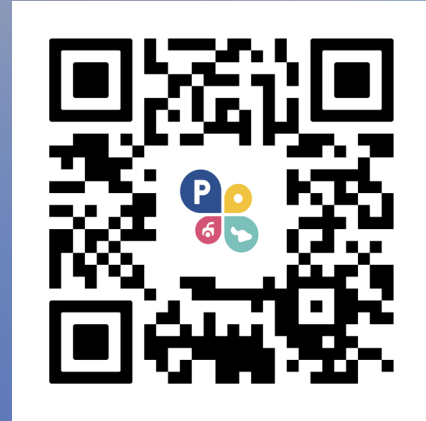
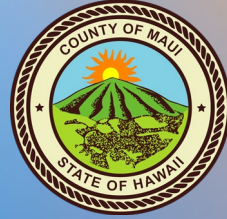
- Adopted to establish permit parking zone at 750 Luakini Lot.
