Ordinance No. 5657, Bill No. 60, CD1, FD2 (2024), as amended, "Fiscal Year 2025 Budget", Appendix A, Part II, Special Purpose Revenues – Schedule of Revolving/Special Funds for Fiscal Year 2025, Managed Retreat Revolving Fund, is amended to add conditional language authorizing the use of funds for removal of structures, tree stumps, and other debris in the conservation zone at Baldwin Beach Park, in the amount of \$100,000, to read as follows:

- (2) Up to \$500,000 must be for Mantokuji Mission of Paia, Maui, including site investigations, permit applications, document preparation, and construction for fuel tank hazard mitigation at Mantokuji Bay.
- (3) Up to \$100,000 must be for the removal of structures, tree stumps, and other debris impacted by shoreline erosion at Baldwin Beach Park.
