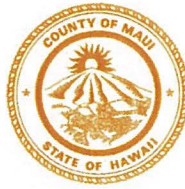

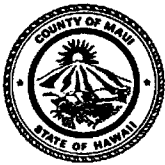

Dale B. Bonar, Ph.D

Biography

Born and raised on O`ahu, Dr. Bonar earned his PhD in Marine Science at UH and spent 16 years as a Professor of Zoology and Research Scientist at the Center of Marine Biotechnology, University of Maryland. Returning to the west coast he founded Aquatic Environmental Sciences, a research and consulting company for marine and freshwater coastal issues. Board service with a local Land Trust resulted in taking over directorship of the Northwest Program of the National Land Trust Alliance. In this position he worked with Land Trusts from Wyoming to Alaska, helping them grow and professionalize. He returned to Maui in 2002 to become Executive Director of the Maui Coastal Land Trust (now the statewide Hawaiian Islands Land Trust) and served as chair of Hawaii's Natural Areas Reserve System and the Legacy Land Conservation Commission.

Following retirement from the Land Trust in 2012, Dale has been active on a number of nonprofit boards and committees, including Maui Nui Marine Resources Council, Hospice Maui, Na Hale O Maui, and now serves as Treasurer for Haleakala Conservancy.
