A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3,  
MAUI COUNTY CODE, ON ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING FEES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a fee for the use of County-owned electric vehicle, or EV, charging stations in order to offset the cost of electricity that is consumed through the EV charging stations. Currently, nearly all electricity expenses associated with the operation of EV charging stations are being paid from the County's general fund, placing an increasing financial burden on limited public resources. The implementation of a user-based charging fee is intended to ensure that those who directly benefit from the service contribute to its operational costs.

This ordinance is structured with the understanding that projected revenue from the proposed fee is minimal and is not intended to generate profit or fund capital improvements, maintenance, or program expansion. Rather, the fee is expected only to partially or fully recover the direct electricity costs currently paid by the general fund.

SECTION 2. Title 3, Maui County Code, is amended by adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

**“Chapter 3.102**

**ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING FEES**

**Sections:**

- 3.102.010 Purpose and intent**
- 3.102.020 Fees**
- 3.102.030 Charging fees – disposition**

**3.102.010 Purpose and intent.** The county has deployed a public electric vehicle charging network across the islands of Maui and Molokai. The purpose of this chapter is to offset the electrical costs incurred by the County for the use of these chargers.

**3.102.020 Fees.** All charging fees are set in the annual budget ordinance.

**3.102.030 Charging fees – disposition.** All electric vehicle charging fees must be deposited in the County’s general fund.”

SECTION 3. This Ordinance takes effect on approval.
