Management, entitled "U.S. Environmental Protection Agency -Water Division, Community Grants" in the amount of \$600,000.

The line will start at Kihei Research and Technology Park, continue north above Kūlanihākoʻi High School, then pass under the Honaapiilani Highway, where it will connect to the existing R-1 recycled water system.
