APPROVING FOR INCLUSION IN THE 2017 MAUI
COUNTY LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE A STATE BILL
PROHIBITING SMOKING IN MOTOR VEHICLES
OCCUPIED BY MINORS UNDER THE AGE OF
THIRTEEN

WHEREAS, it is important to protect young children from exposure to secondhand smoke; and

WHEREAS, current State law does not protect young children from exposure to secondhand smoke in motor vehicles; and

WHEREAS, enactment of State legislation prohibiting smoking in motor vehicles occupied by minors under the age of thirteen years would promote public health; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

1. That the proposed State bill, attached as Exhibit "A," to prohibit smoking in motor vehicles occupied by minors under the age of thirteen years, is approved for inclusion in the 2017 Maui County Legislative Package; and
2. That certified copies of this resolution be transmitted to the Mayor, County of Maui; the Governor, State of Hawaii; the Senate President, State of Hawaii; and the Speaker of the House of Representatives, State of Hawaii.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SMOKING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 328J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§328J- Prohibition in motor vehicles occupied by minors
5 under the age of thirteen years. (a) Smoking shall be prohibited
6 in motor vehicles occupied by minors under the age of thirteen
7 years.

8 (b) For the purposes of this section, "motor vehicle" shall
9 have the same meaning as provided in section 291C-1."

10 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
