A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2026 BUDGET, OFFICE OF THE MAYOR, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM, TO DECREASE APPROPRIATION FOR MOLOKAI AND LĀNA'I YOUTH AND STUDENT TRAVEL, AND ADD CONDITIONAL LANGUAGE FOR LĀNA'I COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 5816, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2026 Budget," Section 3.B.12.c.(2).(xxvi)., Office of the Mayor, Economic Development Program, Grants and disbursements for business development and technology, Sports and Events Promotion, is amended to decrease the appropriation for Molokai and Lāna'i youth and student travel, in the amount of \$100,000 and add new conditional language for Lāna'i Community Association for youth and student travel in the amount of \$100,000, to read as follows:

(a) Up to \$250,000 must be for Maui County residents for participation in and hosting of events.			
(b) Up to [ <del>\$380,000</del> ] <u>\$280,000</u> must be for Molokai and Lāna'i youth and student travel.			
(c) Up to \$20,000 must be for Hāna student travel.			
(d) <u>Up to \$100,000 must be for Lāna'i Community Association for youth and student travel.</u>


