
Seed Orchards for Disease Resistant

Disease-resistant seeds of keystone native trees enable watershed restoration

Established wilt-resistant koa seed orchards are providing Maui landowners with resilient plant material for reforestation and post-fire restoration.

Our next step is developing ROD-resistant 'ōhi'a seed orchards, using seeds strategically we collected over the past 3 years.
