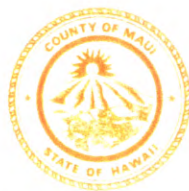

RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF PAUL KAILIPONI TO THE SALARY COMMISSION

WHEREAS, by correspondence dated April 24, 2019, Acting Mayor Sananda K. Baz notified the Council that he nominated Paul Kailiponi to the Salary Commission for a term expiring March 31, 2020, to fill a vacancy replacing Teddy Espeleta, pursuant to Sections 2.40.210 and 2.42.010, Maui County Code (“MCC”), and Sections 8-17.1 and 13-2, Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended, (“Charter”); and


WHEREAS, Section 13-2, Charter, requires the Mayor’s nominee to be approved by the Council; and

3. That certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor, the Managing Director, and the Corporation Counsel.

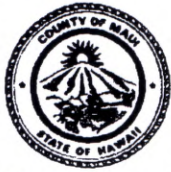
