The Budget, Finance, and Economic Development Committee is in receipt of Bill 101, which amends the Fiscal Year ("FY") 2024 Budget to add \$1,300,000 to the Department of Police's Technical and Support Services Program, Category B – Operations & Equipment, for the purchase of 18 4x4 4-door pursuit vehicles. 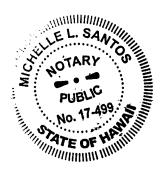

SUBJECT: AMENDMENTS TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET (REVENUES AND DEPARTMENT OF POLICE, TECHNICAL AND SUPPORT SERVICES PROGRAM)

On behalf of the Department of Police, I am transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI, REVENUES AND DEPARTMENT OF POLICE, TECHNICAL AND SUPPORT SERVICES PROGRAM."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to increase Carryover/Savings in the General Fund and Total Estimated Revenues by \$1,300,000 and increase Department of Police, Technical and Support Services Program, Category B; Total Operating Appropriations, Category B and Total Appropriations; and Total Appropriations (Operating and Capital Improvement Projects) by \$1,300,000.

These funds will be used to purchase 18 4x4 4-door Police Pursuit Vehicles. Funds for the purchase of these vehicles were included in the FY 2023 Budget, but when the purchase was put out to bid, the bid came back at approximately \$22,000 more than what was budgeted per vehicle. The purchase of the vehicles was re-bid and the cost came in \$10,000 lower per vehicle. Due to the need to re-bid the purchase, the Department was unable to purchase the vehicles by June 30, 2023, and would like to proceed with the purchase in FY 2024.

The vehicles being replaced are in fair to poor condition and have 70,000 to 144,000 miles or more. These vehicles are needed to minimize the costly vehicle repairs of frequently used and older vehicles. The upkeep and periodic replacement of vehicles is needed for operational safety and well being of both police personnel and the public.
