Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on February 14, 2017, makes reference to County Communication 17-13, from Council Chair Mike White, relating to amendments to Appendix A, Grant Revenue – Schedule of Grants by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2017.

By correspondence dated February 3, 2017, the Budget Director, transmitted a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANT REVENUE – SCHEDULE OF GRANTS BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENT OF POLICE (DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION HIGHWAY SAFETY GRANTS)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Appendix A of the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget by increasing the grant for the Department of Police, Department of Transportation Highway Safety Grants, by \$64,000.

The Budget Director said the grant funds will be used to reduce motor vehicle collision injuries or fatalities to children by ensuring the proper use of child restraints and booster seats through community education and enforcement of child passenger safety laws.

A representative from the Department of Police said within the Traffic Section of the Department, seven different grants are administered relating to highway safety. In particular, the additional funds will enhance child passenger safety programs. He said the funds could also be used for additional training, including child passenger safety and accident investigations; equipment; and recertification courses for police officers.

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4334, Bill No. 62 (2016), Draft 1, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2017 Budget", Appendix A, Part I, Grant Revenue - Schedule of Grants by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2017, is hereby amended as it pertains to the Department of Police, by increasing the appropriation for the Department of Transportation Highway Safety Grants by \$64,000, to read as follows:
