A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2026 BUDGET, OFFICE OF THE MAYOR, ADMINISTRATION PROGRAM, UPDATING CONDITIONAL LANGUAGE FOR HOUSELESS SOLUTIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 5816, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2026 Budget," Section 3.B.12.a.(3), Office of the Mayor, Administration Program, Houseless Solutions, is amended to update the conditional language for Maui Nui Resiliency to develop a Honokōwai Safe Parking Site to delete "a Honokōwai Safe Parking Site," and insert "TMK (2) 4-4-001:106 to accommodate transitional housing and to establish and manage a Resiliency Hub," reduce the amount from \$500,000 to \$400,000, and add new conditional language for a West Maui Safe Parking Site in the amount of \$100,000, to read as follows:

(i) Up to [\$500,000] <u>\$400,000</u> must be for Maui Nui Resiliency Hui to develop [a Honokōwai Safe Parking Site.] <u>TMK (2) 4-4-001:106 to accommodate transitional housing and to establish and manage a Resiliency Hub.</u>			
(ii) <u>Up to \$100,000 must be for a West Maui Safe Parking Site.</u>


