SUBJECT: ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES FOR BED AND BREAKFAST. HOMES AND SHORT-TERM RENTAL HOMES (LU-40)

Thank you for your correspondence dated February 22, 2018. For convenience, I repeat your questions below, followed in turn by my answers.

Question 1: How many complaints did your Department receive within the last 24 months relating to

unpermitted bed and breakfast homes and short-term rental homes?

Answer 1: Over 2016 and 2017, the Department received 307 complaints relating to short-term

rental homes and 41 relating to B&B Homes, for a total of 348.

Question 2: How many of those complaints turned into cases?

Answer 2: Nearly all of the complaints resulted in cases. The complainants usually provide

advertisements or other information clearly indicating the location of the subject

properties, allowing inspectors to take action.

Question 3: Of those cases, how much in fines per month was the Department able to collect?

Answer 3: The average monthly intake for these cases was just over \$4,000 over 2016 and 2017.
