

SUBJECT: TIME EXTENSION ON THE APPOINTMENT OF A COMMITTEE TO REVIEW CHAPTER 5.16 OF THE MAUI COUNTY CODE AS IT RELATES TO TAXICABS

On December 20, 2019, Resolution 19-213 relating to the appointment of a committee by the Mayor to review Chapter 5.16, Maui County Code was adopted. The purpose of the resolution is to investigate proposed rate changes, review license and permit requirements, review the method of computation that determines the number of taxis permitted in the County, and to submit the committee's findings to the County Council no later than August 1, 2020. Due to the severe impact of the COVID-19 pandemic to the operations of the Division of Motor Vehicles and Licensing and taxicab industry, I respectfully requests for a time extension to submit the findings no later than June 30, 2021.
