A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2026 BUDGET, OFFICE OF THE MAYOR, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM, DECREASE THE APPROPRIATION FOR MAKAWAO-PĀ'IA-HA'IKŪ RESIDENCY AREA CLEAN-UP BY \$15,000, AND INCREASE THE APPROPRIATION FOR ALOHA CLASSIC BY \$15,000

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 5816, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2026 Budget," Section 3.B.12.c.(2).(xii), Office of the Mayor, Economic Development Program, Grants and disbursements for business development and technology, Makawao-Pä'ia-Ha'ikū Economic Development, Environmental, and Cultural Programs, is amended to decrease the appropriation for Makawao-Pä'ia-Ha'ikū Residency Area clean-up efforts, security, beautification, maintenance, community outreach, educational events, and economic development, in the amount of \$15,000, and increase the appropriation for Aloha Classic in the amount of \$15,000, to read as follows:
