SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2020: BUDGET DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION (PARKS PROGRAM, WAIEHU GOLF COURSE)

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES; DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION, PARKS PROGRAM (WAIEHU GOLF COURSE); TOTAL OPERATING APPROPRIATIONS; AND TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)
