Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on March 7, 2017, and March 21, 2017, makes reference to the following:

- 1. County Communication 17-13, from Council Chair Mike White, relating to amendments to Appendix A, Grant Revenue Schedule of Grants by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2017.
- 2. County Communication 17-46, from the Budget Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANT REVENUE SCHEDULE OF GRANTS BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENT OF FIRE AND PUBLIC SAFETY (UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY (DHS) FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT (AFG) PROGRAM OPERATIONS AND SAFETY PROGRAM)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Appendix A of the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget by increasing the grant for the Department of Fire and Public Safety, United States Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) Program – Operations and Safety Program, by \$252,050. The total grant amount is \$527,046 and will be used to purchase self-contained breathing apparatus units for fire personnel.

The Fire Chief said the grant will be used to purchase 75 Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus units and 75 replacement cylinders. He said each unit consists of a harness, cylinder, and face piece. The estimated cost per SCBA unit is \$6,000 and each cylinder is \$1,100. He stated the SCBA units are required to meet compliance with the National Fire Protection Association standards.

He noted a 10 percent match, or \$52,704, of non-Federal funds is required to access the grant.

Your Committee voted 8-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading and filing of the communication. Committee Chair Hokama, Vice-Chair White, and members Atay, Cochran, Crivello, Guzman, King, and Sugimura voted "aye." Committee member Carroll was excused.

Your Budget and Finance Committee RECOMMENDS the following:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4334, Bill No. 62 (2016), Draft 1, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2017 Budget", Appendix A, Part I, Grant Revenue - Schedule of Grants by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2017, is hereby amended as it pertains to the Department of Fire and Public Safety, by increasing the appropriation for the United States Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) Program – Operations and Safety Program by \$252,050, to read as follows:
